

Alternate Service for Children's Hearings









Advocacy Service Aberdeen can provide children and young people with an alternate independent advocacy service for Children's Hearings. Possible reasons for referring to an alternate provider can include:



- It ensures a continuity of relationship with a child/young person and an ASA advocacy worker;
- The primary children's hearings advocacy organisation identifies an issue of conflict they are unable to mitigate, for example supporting a parent or sibling of the child/young person; or
- Social Work (or others) make the referral as the child has expressed a desire not to work with the primary organisation due to previous adverse experience.
